

Ottawa City Soccer Club Dispute Resolution Policy

The Ottawa City Soccer Club (OCSC) agrees to abide by Ontario Soccer's published and approved [Dispute Resolution Policy](#) and procedures as an alternative to litigation.

OCSC would appreciate the opportunity to resolve all disputes. In this regard the following procedures should be followed by any parties with concerns:

1. Allow a 24 hour cooling off period before taking any action.
2. First approach is the Technical Director and/or Executive of OCSC.
3. If the TD and/or ED has not resolved the concern satisfactorily, contact the OCSC President who will advise on further or final actions that will be taken.

Note: The Dispute Resolution process shall not to be used for game discipline. Normal discipline and appeals process must be used.
